Propeller Shaft Bearing Housing Service

1. Remove both seals using OMC Puller Bridge P/N 432127 and OMC Large Puller Jaws P/N 432129. Position plate on top of housing to support bridge and tighten jaws securely behind lower seal.

Inspect the bearings in place. If a bearing is removed for any reason it must be replaced.

- 28 29 2. Remove either bearing using OMC Puller Bridge P/N 432127 and OMC Large Puller Jaws P/N 432129. Rest puller plate on top of housing to support bridge and tighten jaws securely behind bearing.
- 3. Clean housing and bearings in solvent and dry thoroughly. If bearings were not replaced, rotate needles with your fingers to check for freedom of movement. Inspect O-ring groove and sand off any sharp edges that would cut O-ring and prevent its sealing.
- 4. Thoroughly clean the four bearing housing retaining screws in solvent. Discard the retaining screws' O-rings.
- 5. Inspect the bearing housing anode. Replace anode if it has been reduced to two-thirds its original size (one-third eroded).
